Some customers will find that they need to update their computer equipment for Sacs.Net. As part of your upgrade plan, you will need to evaluate your current equipment to insure that it will work efficiently with Sacs.Net. Listed below are some of the recommendations:

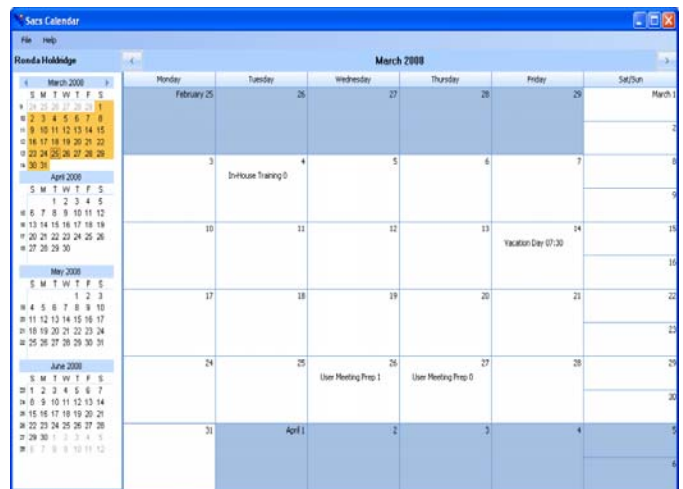
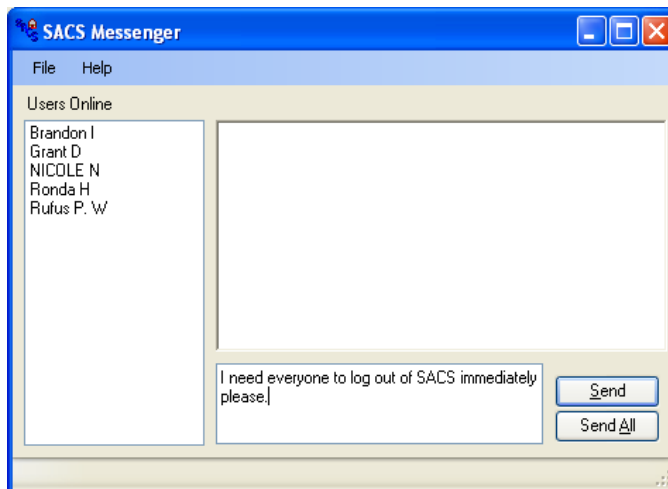

Announcing SACS Productivity Suite

SACS is proud to introduce the SACS Productivity Suite. This suite contains a text messaging system as well as a calendar for scheduling appointments. The SACS.Net Productivity Suite allows you to make easy contact with users logged into SACS as well as scheduling appointments with the Calendar program.



The Calendar Program interfaces with the Annual Recertify and Inspection Scheduling to give you easy access to see what tenants are scheduled for their annuals and inspections.

HUD News

PIC began transitioning their computer system from development numbers to AMP numbers on April 4, 2008. The transition is now completed; you can now submit HUD-50058 information using either development numbers "AL174001" or using the new AMP number "AL174000001". You will have one year to change your development numbers in SACS to your assigned AMP numbers.

If you had duplicate building/unit numbers that were not corrected before the transition, these were changed during the transition. You will need to change these in SACS to match what is in PIC or the 50058s associated with these units will be rejected. For detailed instructions on changing this information in SACS download Technical Notice 145 (Sacs Classic) or Technical Notice 3 (Sacs Net) from our website.

On March 31, 2008 HUD released PIH Notice 2008-16, "Guidance on Asset Management Provisions in the Consolidate Appropriations Act". This notice addresses the exemption of asset management for PHAs between 250-400 units. HUD interprets the provisions of the act to provide a one extension of the asset management requirements.

Technical Support

Sacs.Net gives you the ability to email program exceptions to SACS. If you receive a pop-up box with an exception message, please click on the Email to Sacs option and then give our technical support department a call. The technician can use the information in the email to help diagnose the problem.

With the integration of SACS.Net and Microsoft Office, you have the ability to create, edit and personalize your letters and leases. Your housing authority logo and any digital signatures can also be added to give your documents a professional look.
